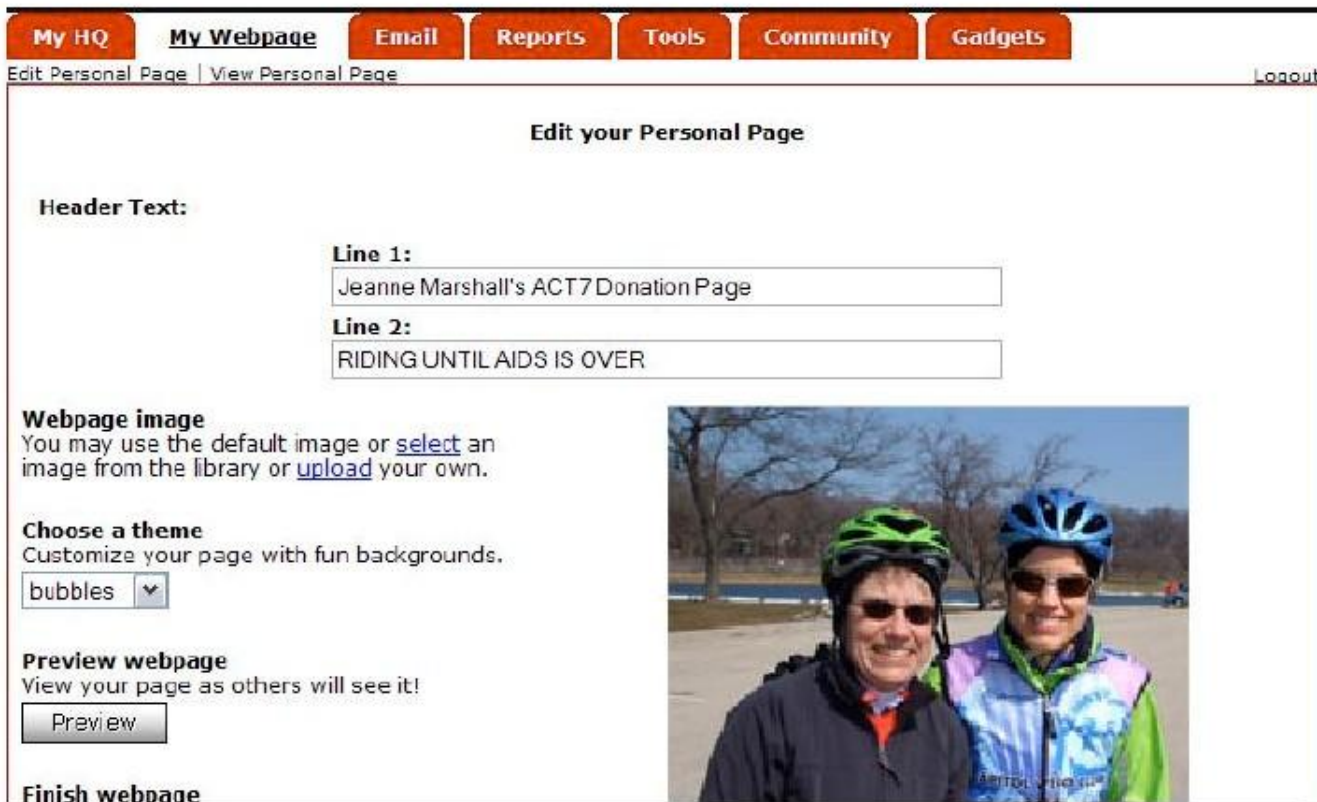


Using ACT 8's actride.kintera.org registration system, you're only a few steps away from creating an easy place for anyone, anywhere to donate to the cause! Creating a fundraising page will give you your own website to raise money for ACT 8. Your donors can navigate to it and make a secure online pledge to you. It's a great way to get additional exposure and increase your base of potential donors!



You can set up your page as soon as you complete your registration or you can come back at anytime to your personal HQ using the address in your registration e-mail. Your HQ page will look similar to this one.

Click on Build/Edit my Webpage which is part of My To Do List.



Enter a title for your webpage in the Line 1 box.
 Enter a theme for your fundraising in the Line 2 box.
 Decide whether you want to upload your own picture or select one from the image library.
 To upload your own image, you must first edit your picture so it is 300 X 234 pixels and no more than 50 Kb in size. You can use any image editing software for this purpose.

Click on the Browse button and find the file that you wish to upload. Click on the file name to select your file. The file name will be displayed in the little gray box. Click on the Submit button to upload your image and then click on the blue link, "Click [here to return](#)" to return to the main webpage editing area.

You can select the standard theme (blank background) or any of the other themes; check out the ribbon or bubbles themes, for example.

Caption under image:

Enter the caption you want for your picture or leave the default phrase, "Join me in my efforts to support AIDS Network."

Edit the text:

Then type the main message you want on your fundraising page in the box labeled Edit the text:

Once you have completed these steps, click the Preview button to decide if you like your webpage.

If you like your results, you are ready to save your page. To save your changes click on the Submit button as shown below.

Finish webpage

To complete your webpage or to save changes, click Submit.

If you are not satisfied, go back and update the part of your page that you do not like, repeat the preview step and the submit step when you are satisfied with your page's content.

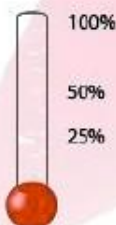
